



## Lennick Faculty Fellow

### **Application Components**

The application for the Lennick Faculty Fellowship consists of the following elements:

- A 3-5 page proposal describing the research, including background, significance, literature review summary, research question, methods, and expected practical applications and timeline.
- A 2-page project bibliography.
- CV including past publications
- A proposed budget for the research
- Two references.

### **Evaluation Criteria**

Demonstrated excellence of applicant and proposed research project, including:

- Applicant body of work and alignment with t2pRI interest areas.
- Project quality, including intellectual merit and contribution to the field.
- Anticipated practical application of the findings to organizations, including businesses and nonprofits, and individuals wishing to develop their leadership.
- Proposed use of funds.

### **Application Submission Process**

Applications should be submitted to Kate Berman at [kberman@t2pri.org](mailto:kberman@t2pri.org) by the specified deadline date.

### **Review Process**

Only completed applications will be reviewed. The review process consists of two steps:

1. The completed application will be reviewed and ranked by the t2pRI Fellowship Review Committee, consisting of members of the t2pRI Board of Directors.
2. Highly-ranked applicants will be invited to interview with the t2pRI Fellowship Review Committee.

A final decision will be made on the basis of the above two steps.
